1. Implementation of the new Labor Laws Compliance System (LLCS) our part developmental-part regulatory system of assessing and monitoring the voluntary compliance of establishments with Labor Laws and Standards

Priority sectors include construction, maritime and transport sectors; security agencies and the subcontractors

2. Incentivizing Compliance Program (ICP) which recognizes establishments for compliance with labor laws which include the following awards :
 - Tripartite Certificate of Compliance with Labor Standards (TCCLS)
 - Gawad Kaligtasan at Kalusigan (GKK)
 - Outstanding Labor Management Council (LMC)
 - Child Labor Free Establishment (CLFE)
 - Productivity Olympics

Corollary activities include numerous trainings and capacity building activities for our personnel relative to the implementation of the different DOLE Programs.

Congratulations to the newly elected Officers and members of the Board of ASPPI and I look forward to more collaborative projects with you as our long-time partner in the furtherance of OSH.
